Submission deadline: 31 May, 2025

When submitting, please take the following into account:

- Scan or clear picture of the work file no larger than 2 MB
- Submit as .jpg or .png
- File name should contain: the child's name, age and country
- Multiple entries at once (e.g. per class)? Please send all works as separate files (via email or WeTransfer)
- Subject of the email: ICBD Illustration Competition
- Submissions can only be made digitally.
- Every child in primary school age (up to and including 12 years) can participate.
- By submitting you agree that your artwork, first name and country may be made public on the website and other channels of IBBY-Nederland.

Prizes

The prizes below will be awarded in two age categories: Children up to and including 8 years and children from 9 to and including 12 years.

1 winner from the Netherlands – two books + a book package (10 books) for school

- 1 international winner two books + a book package (10 books) for school
- 2 honourable mentions two books

The jury will assess the following criteria:

- Creativity and originality
- Relevance to the theme "The Freedom of Imagination"
- Power and message of the work
- Visual attractiveness
